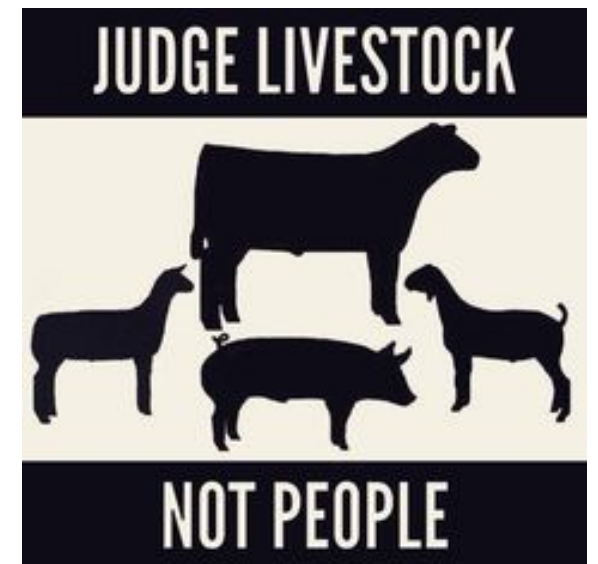
CONGRATULATIONS CARCASS CHAMPIONS

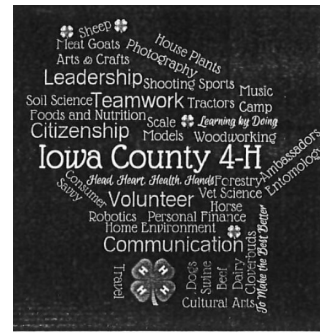

IT'S 4-H RE-ENROLLMENT TIME!

Online re-enrollment will be the same as in the past years. <https://wi.4honline.com>

✓ Youth in 3rd grade this year are full 4-H members and are able to choose from any of the projects listed. Youth in K-2nd grade can choose from Cloverbud 1, Cloverbud 2 or Cloverbud 3.

✓ **Current members must re-enroll by December 1 to be eligible for trips, county fair, camp and other 4-H events and activities. New members can join anytime, however if you want to exhibit at the 2020 fair, you must be enrolled by April 1.**

✓ The enrollment fee must be paid to your 4-H leader when you re-enroll. The fee is \$10 per youth member, or \$30 for a family of three or more. Please make checks payable to: Iowa County 4-H.

✓ If you are interested in being a 4-H volunteer leader, enroll online and plan to attend a volunteer orientation program. **See below for next program.**
