To go or not to go? Making decisions about activities and events during COVID-19



SITUATION	 What will the activity or event be like? Activities are lower risk when they are short, infrequent, outdoors and involve fewer people. What <u>safety measures</u> will there be (masking, outdoor setting, enough space for physical distancing, vaccination against COVID-19)?
LOCAL	 How much is COVID-19 <u>spreading locally</u> (high daily case count, high positive testing rate)? Are many people still <u>unvaccinated</u> in your area?
POTENTIAL RISKS	 Does anyone involved have a <u>higher risk of serious illness</u>, such as older age or health problems? Is it likely that someone involved has been exposed to the virus, such as at school or work? If someone involved does get very sick, would nearby <u>hospitals</u> have space to care for them?
POTENTIAL BENEFITS	What are the possible benefits?Do the benefits outweigh the risks?
