_3. 4-H Activity: Check all boxes for club activities, county activities, district, state, and national activities. Be sure to sign and date sheet, and have guardians add comments on $4-\mathrm{H}$ year.
$\qquad$ 4. 4-H Story: Include ideas about:
a. Memorable things that happen in 4-H.
b. Things you learned and how you will apply them.
c. What you most enjoyed in 4-H.
d. What 4-H means to you.
e. Experiences at club meetings, community service, project experience, events, fair, etc.
$\qquad$ 5. Member Project Pages: One form is filled out for each project you choose to highlight in your record book. Choose either Animal Pages or Non-Animal Pages to fill out. Financial Records and Income and Project Inventory are all filled out.
a. Write a story about your project.
b. Show off your project with pictures.
