



PLANNING EMERGENCY LIVESTOCK TRANSPORT RESPONSE (PELTR)

For first responders, dispatchers, highway departments, and state, county, and emergency management to develop their toolbox for responding to livestock transportation crashes. First responders statewide are encouraged to attend, but class size is limited, with preference given to the Waushara and Iowa Counties.
