Scholarship Requirements & Eligibility

In order to be considered for this scholarship, you must be a high school senior up to 21 years of age. As a high school senior, the essay question regarding your future plans to enter the agriculture industry or commitment to a university will be considered for eligibility. If you are selected, you must provide proof of enrollment to receive the award.

If you are a high school graduate, you must be currently enrolled in a 2-4 year university agriculture program or enrolled in a certification program to meet the scholarship requirements. If selected, scholarship funds will be sent directly to your school.

Below is a checklist of what you need to provide with your application as well as examples of how to meet the qualification. You must attach just one form of proof for each category.

High School Graduate Option 1: Proof of Enrollment in Agriculture Major/Career Path



 - Enrollment in a 2-4 year university/college agriculture program
 - Unofficial transcripts (Preferred)
 - Enrollment Verification Letter from Registrar's Office
 - Student ID with Term Stickers/Details
 - Class Schedule for 2025

Essay Question #3: Applying YQCA Knowledge

This question is worth 25 points. Please limit your response to a 200 word count maximum.

What knowledge have you gained from your experience in the YQCA program, and how have you applied it in your life? Please describe how it has influenced your background or given you experiences that relate to agriculture.
