The Iowa County 4-H program uses an application and interview process to support youth in building life skills as they pursue extraordinary 4-H opportunities and recognitions, including:

- 4-H Key Award Top award a WI 4-H Youth can receive (10<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup> Gr)
- 4-H College Scholarships Funds for post-high school education (12<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup> Gr)

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Part 1 Application: Youth must submit the following google form and depending on the experience the youth must complete a cover letter, resume, essay question, and collect recommendation letter(s).

Part 2 Interview: Youth applicants who are applying for the 4-H Key Award will participate in an interview with a small panel of 4-H adult volunteers and community members. Scholarships do not require an interview.

#### Section 3: Key Award

In this section you will apply for the 4-H Key Award. This award is the highest award a 4-H member can receive in Wisconsin 4-H. It recognized members in 10th-13th grade who have shown consistent growth in their 4-H program, developed leadership abilities, and been helpful to other members in their club and community. Youth must have completed at least three years of 4-H club membership.

Award application materials REQUIRED: Cover Letter, Resume, Essay, 2 Recommendation Forms/Letters, Application Reflection, Interview Preference Form, and address the Iowa County Board of Supervisors.

\*IMPORTANT NOTE: If you are not applying for the 4-H Key Award, you can skip this section.

#### Q1: 4-H Adult Leaders Scholarships

Applicants must be enrolled in Iowa County 4-H at the time of application, have been enrolled in Iowa County 4-H for at least three (3) years, graduating from 4-H, and be enrolled or planning to enroll at a university, college, or technical school during the upcoming academic school year. Applicants may only be awarded this scholarship once. Annually, there scholarships available and awarded at the discretion of the interview committee.

#### Q2: Shelly Osterndorff 4-H Scholarship

Shelly Osterndorff dedicated over twenty-two years to Iowa County 4-H, serving as a club leader for the Rewey Lucky Stars 4-H club and in multiple positions within the Leaders Association. Shelly had a passion for agriculture and an even greater love for 4-H where she enjoyed watching and teaching every 4-H member she met. Shelly's family and the Rewey Lucky Stars 4-H club are honored to present a scholarship in her memory.

Applicants must be enrolled in the Iowa County 4-H at the time of application either as a current senior or graduating member. Applicants must be enrolled in Iowa County 4-H for at least three (3) years and be enrolled or planning to enroll at a university, college, or technical school during the upcoming academic year. Annually, the scholarships available and awarded are at the discretion of the Osterndorff family/Rewey Lucky Stars Leaders.

If you are applying for a trip experience the cover letter and resume <u>are required</u> for: Advanced Space Camp, Citizenship Washington Focus, National 4-H Conference, National 4-H Congress, and American Spirit East.

A cover letter and resume are <u>NOT</u> needed for: Space Camp, Fall Forum, or Summer Academy. If you are applying for one of these three you may skip this section.
